Educational Program Focus:

- **Developing Volunteers To Support Positive Youth Development**

Provide training and support to 91 volunteers who support six community clubs, one youth council, 4-H in the classroom, local and regional fairs, competitive events, and camping programs.

Provide educational experiences in the form of clubs, field days, day camps, competitive events and school enrichment programs for approximately 915 youth annually.
